Overview:

Digital Film Skills is a specialist, free training scheme for freelancers from diverse, under-represented groups, seeking to sustain work in craft and technical areas of the film industry as camera assistants, assistant editors and production assistants. The programme comprises of seminars delivered by industry professionals, and is followed by one-to-one support for each participant by a carefully matched mentor, these have included award winning professionals in previous years.

There are 12 places, offered free to London-based participants who can provide evidence of low-waged status. People from diverse backgrounds are particularly encouraged to apply. This programme is aimed at those who have been freelancing at a low wage for 1-2 years within the film and TV industry.

Places will be allocated by application and interview.
